This product is intended for professional investors.

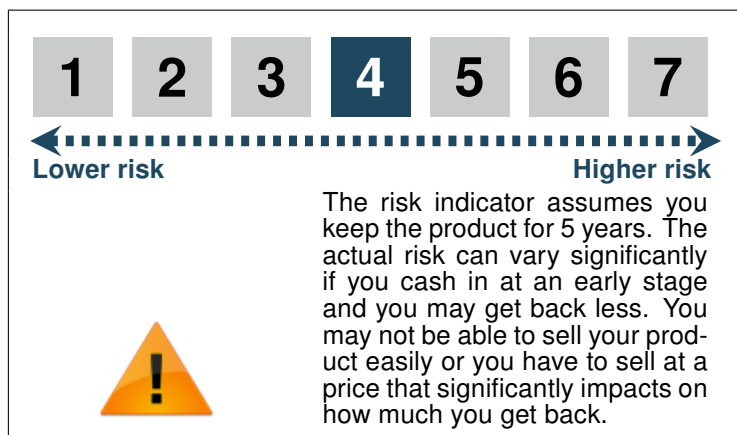
Term of product:

Costs over time
